

## **INTELLECTUAL FREEDOM**

Rockford Public Library supports the principles of intellectual freedom adopted by the American Library Association and stated in the Library Bill of Rights (see Appendices).

The Library assures equal access to all library resources by patrons within the constraints of Illinois law. Patrons are free to select or reject themselves any item in the collection. Individual or group prejudice about a particular item or type of material in the collection may not preclude its use by others. Parents or legal guardians have the right and the responsibility to restrict the access of their children to library resources. Parents or legal guardians who do not want their children to have access to certain library services, materials or facilities, should so advise their children. Library staff cannot assume the role of parents or the functions of parental authority in the private relationship between parent/guardian and child.
